The Reford Gardens

Les Jardins de Méfis/Reford Gardens, located at the gateway to the Gaspé Peninsula on the banks of the St. Lawrence and Méfis rivers, are one of North America’s premier garden and tourist destinations. Created by Elsie Reford over a period of 30 years, they are a living testimony to her passion for gardening and plants. Today, her great grandson, Alexander Reford, leads a team committed to preserving this national historic site and unique horticultural heritage.

The Estevan Lodge

Estevan Lodge is an outstanding example of the historic fishing camps of the Gaspé Peninsula. Built in 1887, it is a cultural space that hosts many activities presented in collaboration with local arts organizations spotlighting artists, musicians, writers, storytellers, speakers and guest chefs. No visit to the gardens is complete without sampling some of our culinary offerings. In Estevan Lodge, experience the menu of Chef Pierre-Olivier Ferry that features highlights of the gardens’ horticultural collections.



The International Garden Festival

The International Garden Festival is recognized as one of the most important events of its kind in North America and one of the leading annual garden festivals in the world. Since 2000, more than one million visitors have discovered over 165 contemporary and ephemeral gardens created by designers from 15 countries. This artistic and tourism event also gives visitors a chance to discover inspiring spaces bringing together the visual arts, architecture, design, landscape and the environment. The Festival is an annual *rendez-vous* for admirers of contemporary gardens and design as well as offering a unique creative space for those involved in the renewal of this art form.


Lambmowers / Les Moutondeuses

In three micro-pastures adjacent to our parking area, the lambs help control a large surface that was previously mowed every week by the gardens' staff and lawnmowers.

Estevan Lodge Restaurant

A cuisine featuring the unique tastes from the gardens' plant collection. More than 150 edible plants are picked daily in our vegetable and picking garden.

Our *mise en bouche*, the Garden Spoon, offers a taste of the gardens from 15 edible flowers in a single bite. The dining rooms are open from mid-June to the end of August, every day from 11 :30 am to 2 :30 pm.



Other services

You will also find two cafés offering light lunches, snacks and refreshments and two gift shops offering you souvenirs from your visit in the gardens, such as seeds, garden books, hand-made goods and more. Guided tours are offered for groups (reservation required). Parking for buses, umbrellas, wheelchairs and strollers.

Policy
