


By inserting a waving metal ribbon inside a blanket of mist around the feet of two pre-existing trees, we propose to blur spatial boundaries and to intersect both real and imaginary spaces of unknown roots and origins and change our perception of nature over time.

The roots of the trees are literally blurred, and an atmosphere is created where the visitor will need to become aware of their bodies and the vegetation protruding through the mist. The constantly evolving atmosphere allows the user to interact with the ambient change, the existing trees and herbaceous plants which emerge through the mist, all of which is encircled by the waving metal ribbon. This steel belt will protrude through the mist as either a table, a bar, a seat or whatever the user makes it - the audience will be able to rest there while looking up the forest as the rays of light materialise themselves through the mist cloud. Temporarily engulfed, the installation is as alive as the summer sun and the breeze from the river will animate the mist throughout the day. As the sun pokes through the forest during the day it creates a crepuscular ray effect.

The visitor will embark on a journey where their perception of the forest is constantly evolving.


Suggested Plants:

- Wavy hairgrass *Avenella flexuosa*
- Tufted hairgrass *Deschampsia cespitosa*
- Large false Solomon's seal *Maianthemum racemosum*
- Heart-leaved aster *Symphotrichum cordifolium*
