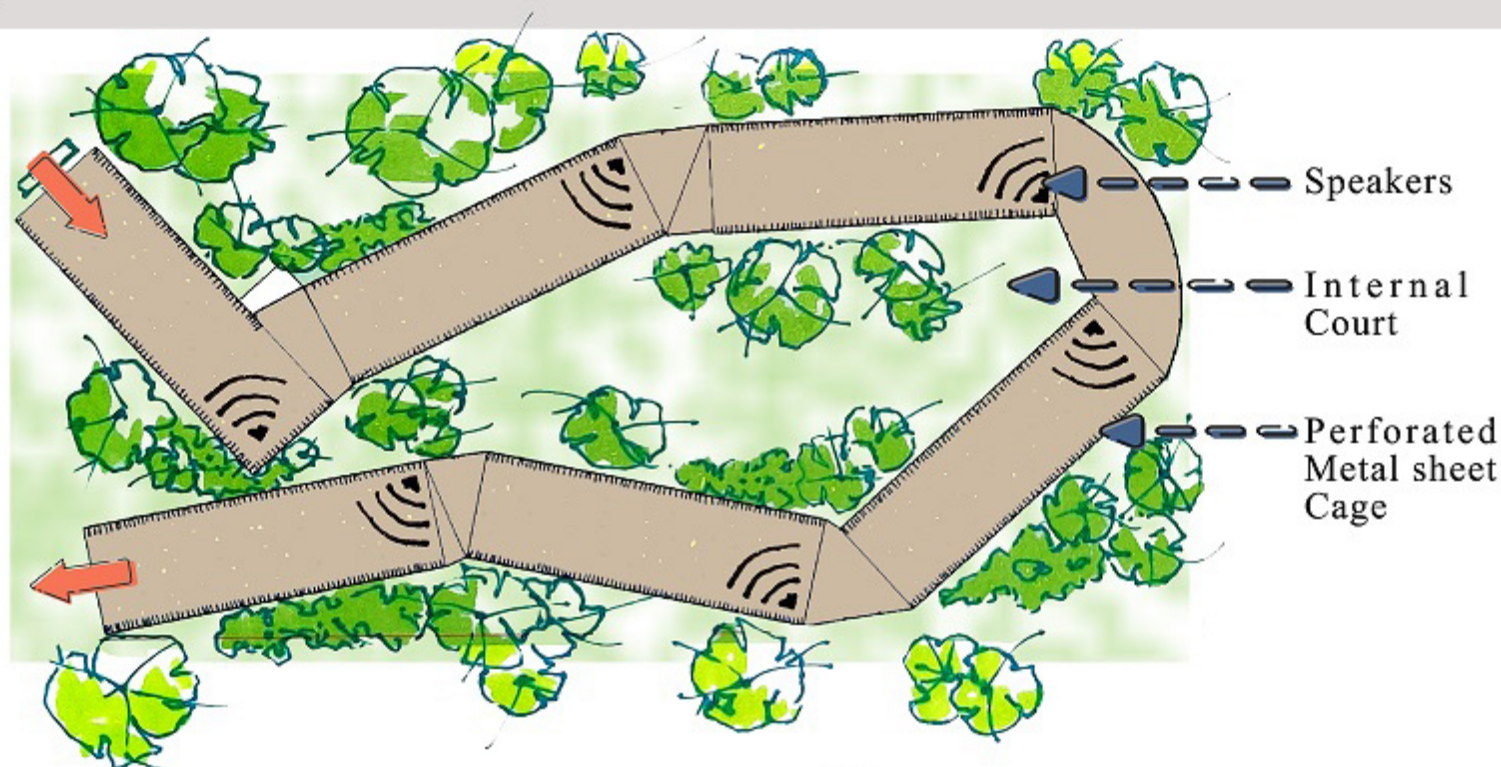


Awakening Senses

Our design installation aims to reverse this relationship wherein the nature and ecosystem is at the forefront and urbanization takes a back seat by amplifying the experiences of various interactions among the natural elements, seasonal variations and spatial characteristics of spaces. The design proposal includes a trail through fabricated cage including sounds of nature and scented plants surrounding it which help to stimulate and energize psychology of human by restoring natural environment in the urban development.

The sound and scents of nature, the play of shade and light through different times of the day, the seasonal changes in colour and texture will be inseparable experiential qualities of unseen natural elements inducing powerful emotions of not only what we see but also what we feel.

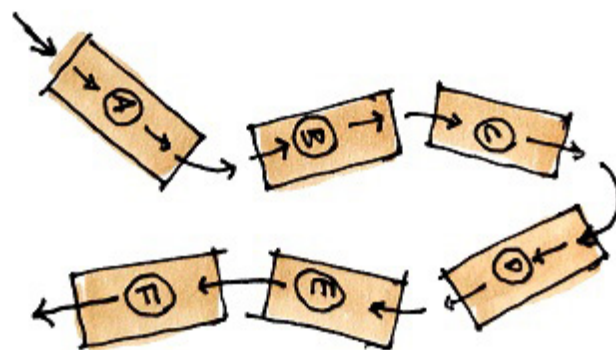

6. Thalictrum Pubescens

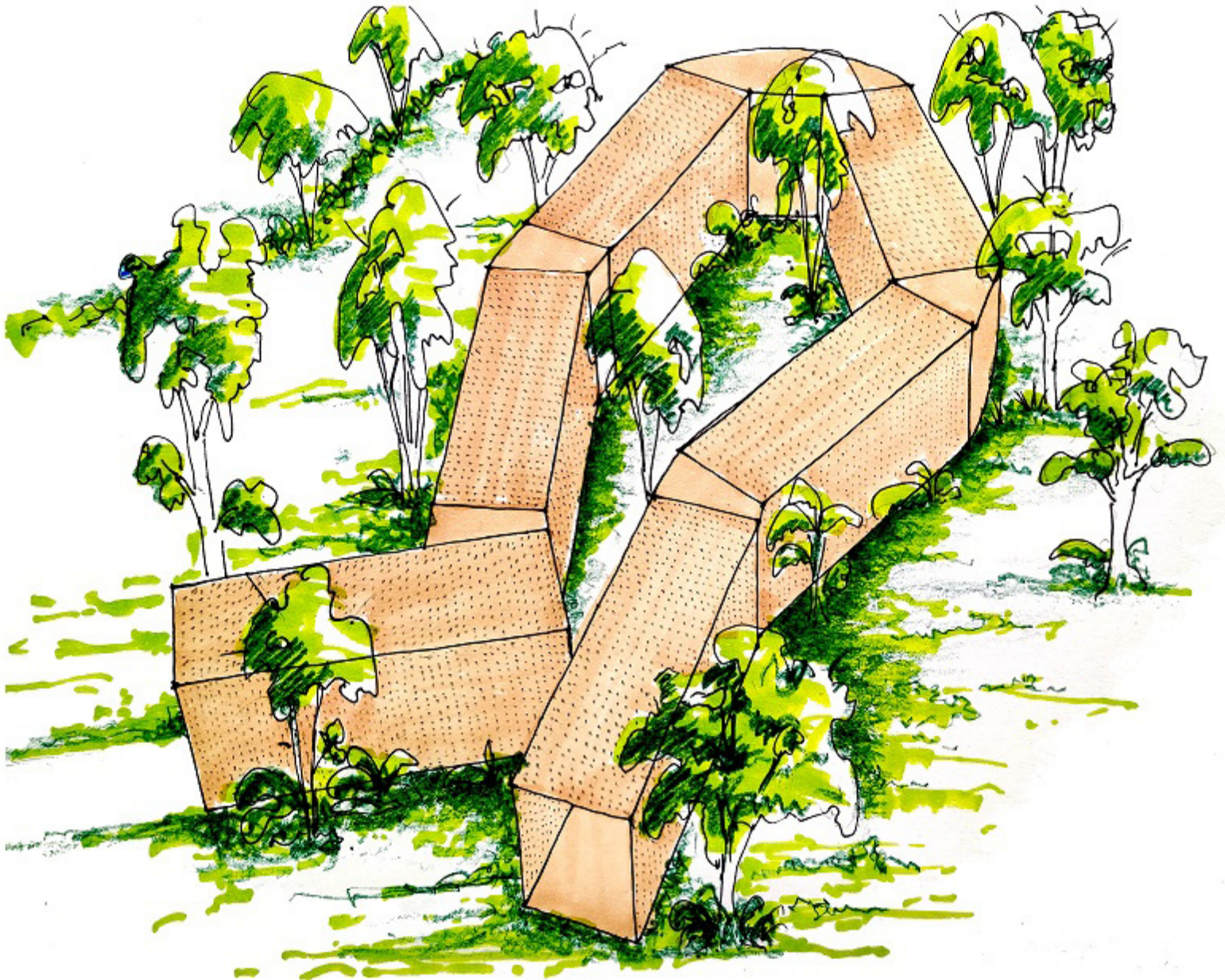
List of Trees:
